### **Start Procedure**

The rally will start from the service exit control on the Patrick Festival Field.

To reduce the risk of vehicles, especially cars, being trapped in their service area it is requested that competitors do not line up more than 5 minutes before their assigned start minute.

### **Finish Procedure**

The last official time control of the rally is the FTC on SS9 CJ's Loop. This FTC will also be treated as the final MTC for the event. Competitors do NOT need to declare an MTC time.

Any Parc Fermé requests will be made at this FTC/MTC. Competitors who must Parc Fermé will be instructed to return to Patrick Service via the route provided within the Route Book. Competitors who are not required to attend Parc Fermé have finished the rally. If a competitor has finished the rally, there is no required transit. The route book contains a route to either the service park or Cheraw, SC.

### **Scrutineering**

Scrutineering for Cars (including SxS) and Bikes will again be located at Watson's Hot Rod Garage located at 23 Chesterfield Hwy, Cheraw, SC.

There will be no logbooks issued during scrutineering hours. If your car requires a logbook, contact your closest scrutineer now to arrange to have it done before Sandblast.

Vehicles presented for scrutineering must already have all required elements in place. No "stickering", repairs, or additions required to pass scrutineering will be allowed while in scrutineering.

Vehicles to be inspected, and crew, will remain outdoors during scrutineering, weather permitting. If we need to move scrutineering indoors, we ask that crews presenting cars wear masks.

We ask that all competitors arriving at the vicinity of Watson's Garage with competition vehicles on/in trailers/trucks park the truck/trailer in the lot marked in green across Chesterfield Hwy from Watson's and drive the competition vehicle to the entrance, or queue line, outside scrutineering on Robey St.

Access to scrutineering areas will be limited to scrutineering staff and no more than 2 service crew per vehicle.

Entry into area marked Cars and Bikes will be limited to 2 vehicles and their crews at a time. Entry will be from Robey. Exit will be onto Chesterfield Hwy (Rt 9).

Once the vehicle has been inspected, it should be moved from the scrutineering area. If it did not pass (did not receive a tech sticker), it will be necessary to come back thru once deficiencies have been corrected.

Logbooks will be retained by Scrutineering at this event. The logbook event entry info for Sandblast 2021 should already be completed by the competitor prior to entering Scrutineer. Preprinted vehicle specific tech sheets will already be in the possession of Scrutineering and will be completed by scrutineering when the vehicle is presented and will be retained by scrutineering.
